What is the Community Support Program and Who Does the Program Serve?

The Community Support Program (CSP) of the Allendale Association is designed to make mental health services available to children and their families who might not have ready access to mental health services because of limitations imposed by financial resources, physical disabilities, transportation or other similar obstacles that would prevent the child and family from using counseling services provided in a mental health clinic. The program provides community-based individual and family counseling services for children and adolescents experiencing behavioral or emotional problems at home, school or in the community. "Community-based" means the counseling services can be provided in the home, school, or other accessible and appropriate community location.

What are the Admission Requirements?

Residence: The child and family must be residents of Lake County.

Age: 3 years through 17 years of age.

Types of Issues Addressed in the Program:

- Depression • Anxiety • Attention Problems – Hyperactivity • Delinquency • Truancy
- School Issues • Aggressive Behaviors • Oppositional Behaviors • Peer Relationships
- Family Relationships • Trauma Related Emotional or Behavioral Disturbances


Helping Families Through Community Support!
