Greenhouse Projects:

- Supporting Special Projects: such as "Prairie Restoration/Butterfly Sanctuary"
- Maintaining/Harvesting "mini orchard"
- Propagation: seeding, cutting, and dividing
- Soil preparation: mixing soil components
- Flats/Pots preparation: putting flat components together and filling flats and pots with soil
- Transplanting plants: upsizing and/or refreshing soil
- Weeding: removal of weeds from pots and gardens
- General greenhouse and gardens maintenance and cleaning
