



SAFETY MEASURES FOR RETURNING TO IN-PERSON INSTRUCTION AT ALLENDALE SCHOOL

Any staff or student showing any signs or symptoms of illness should stay home.

WELLNESS-CHECKS

Staff, students, and visitors participate in daily wellness and temperature screenings.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

Measures in place to reduce classroom mixing; signs and space markers placed throughout school buildings.

FACE COVERINGS

Staff, students, and visitors required to wear face coverings unless outside at least 6 feet from others.

HAND HYGIENE

Hands should be washed frequently with soap and water for 20 seconds; staff provides hand sanitizer when hand washing is not accessible.

INCREASED CLEANING

Besides nightly disinfecting, school staff frequently clean and disinfect high touch areas throughout the day.

VISITORS

Visitation remains by appointment only as campus is closed to all non-essential visitors; meetings whenever possible will take place via conference.

TRAINING

Staff and students trained in proper hand hygiene, use of face coverings and health and safety protocols for COVID-19.

ILLNESS/EXPOSURE

Staff and students must be 72 hours fever free without fever-reducing medication and 10 days must have passed since symptoms first appeared to return to school; following COVID-19 exposure all must quarantine for 14 days.
