Specialized Education Services

REMOTE LEARNING KEEPS OUR STUDENTS ENGAGED:

When the 2019-2020 school year started, it was business as usual at Allendale. Teachers & Teacher's Aids were busy getting their classrooms ready and kids were excited for the new school year ahead. By the time March rolled around with news of a global pandemic, the world changed overnight and we were forced to change with it.

We had to be flexible, adapting to ever-changing guidelines and best practices. We quickly developed a plan for the continuity of education for our residential and day treatment students at our Lake Villa and Woodstock campuses.

While school remained closed, our innovative school staff actively worked with our residential youth providing educational enrichment activities and supported day treatment students and families with remote learning options and technology to ensure continued learning and services.

Our staff and community came together in support of our youth... highlighting Allendale's core value of working together and revealing that our greatest strength is in each other.

Today, as communities gradually re-open with increased access to various services and venues, Allendale as well, shall be transitioning toward a new stage as we begin to re-emerge beyond the confines of our cosseted environments and into situations allowing for greater community engagement and in-person interactions.

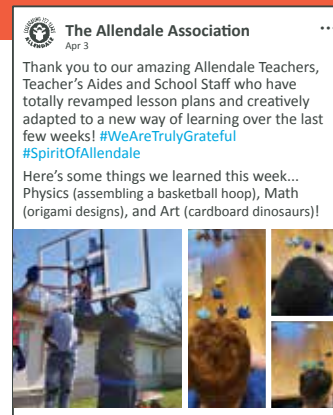

How we persevered through uncertain times:

- **Our school program provided educational enrichment activities to all of our 120 residential youth and remote learning to more than 80 day treatment students from our Stepping Stone and LINC programs.**
- **Our Educational Services Team imaginatively and creatively celebrated our Class of 2020 comprised of 21 8th Grade and High School Graduates.**
- **Our Embroidery Teacher, with the help of a few staff, manufactured over 200 masks for staff and youth to wear for protection.**
- **Our Career & Tech Ed Instructors completely re-designed their programs to offer interactive projects without always having access to their respective facilities and shops.**
- **Our IT Department ensured we had the necessary equipment (computers, televisions, video conferencing, Disney+) and Wi-Fi infrastructure to support an environment that almost immediately became significantly more dependent upon technology to stay connected.**

EVERYONE COMES TOGETHER TO HELP OUR KIDS:

As stay-at-home orders lingered on, Allendale youth experienced the same feelings as many others... frustration, boredom and even anger as we all adjusted to quarantine and fought "cabin fever".

Our Residential staff worked tirelessly helping our youth address their feelings, adapt to home learning in our cottages, while balancing school/life chores and responsibilities... a delicate balance, even without the added stress of a global pandemic.

Allendale is so fortunate to be situated on 120 acres nestled on the banks of Cedar Lake, offering our youth and staff much-needed fresh air, space to spread out and just breathe when we need a break. As the weather got warmer and the lake was reopened, youth enjoyed countless hours swimming, kayaking, paddle boarding and enjoying our private beach front... something we may have taken for granted in years past.

Friends and community supporters donated games, activities, supplies and dinners out to help break up the monotony. Our Therapeutic Recreation staff organized amazingly creative activities and utilized every inch of our campus, from sports fields to hiking trails, which allowed us to enjoy the outdoors, get some exercise and still have fun! A palpable sense of unity across the agency emerged as staff and kids began to exude the strength of Allendale.

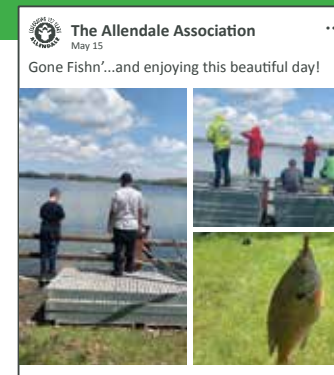

We are proud of our accomplishments, against the odds:

- **Allendale's Health Services Department kept youth and staff's health and safety at the forefront; convening an Emergency Response Team who met daily to re-evaluate agency needs, coordinating closely with local municipalities and first responders, anticipating and planning for various contingencies and communicating guidelines with staff.**
- **Our residential program maintained an average census of 120 youth remaining safely in our care, including admitting 11 new youth, successfully discharging 9 youth and even expanding our Autism program!**
- **Our Facilities & Housekeeping Departments worked tirelessly cleaning and disinfecting, making modifications to units to improve ventilation and accommodate physical distancing requirements, and quickly renovated 3 spaces to create quarantine areas.**
- **A'viands, our Food Service vendor, abruptly adapted to providing "To-Go" meals following the closing of our cafeteria and remained immensely flexible.**
- **Our Board & Donors completed a capital campaign, raising over \$370,000 towards building a new Therapeutic Games Room on our Lake Villa Campus.**
- **Our Becker Group Home was re-designed to become more community-centered, with plans in place to expand programs to help ease the transition for youth back into the community.**

TELE-THERAPY BECOMES A VIABLE OPTION:

COVID-19 changed our daily lives and interactions. No work. No school. No physical contact with extended family and friends. It also sparked a range of emotions and reactions within each of us.

Our Outpatient Therapists adapted to the changing needs of our clients and surrounding community, quickly and efficiently transitioning from one-on-one therapy sessions to providing tele-therapy via phone and/or video.

Our treatment teams engaged with our youth across all programs, helping them understand what was happening and the implications of the pandemic, while empowering them to help our entire Allendale community come together. We remained an accessible mental health resource to our current clients and surrounding community as isolation became more difficult and challenging.

We are proud to serve, even in turbulent times:

- **Our Foster Care team supported 37 youth and families through weekly virtual meetings, while experiencing NO placement disruptions.**
- **Our Foster Care team also celebrated with several families this past year, including 6 adoptions, 4 reunifications and 1 guardianship!**
- **Our Outpatient Counseling program shifted to providing tele-psychiatric and tele-health services exclusively and while this switch was almost immediate, nearly 80% of our current clients have remained engaged in virtual services with their therapist. We also welcomed 48 new clients who reached out and enrolled in our outpatient services.**
- **Allendale's Bradley Counseling Center, offered valuable insight and resources to the community, authoring 4 newspaper articles on coping skills during COVID-19, which were published in the Daily Herald.**
- **Allendale shared a bi-weekly "Tip of the Day" helpful tips, tools and topics via posts on our Facebook page between March-May to offer hopeful reassurance that someone is always available to help!**
- **As an agency, Allendale offered caring support to employees; adjusting schedules for staff who needed to stay home due to closed daycares, to care for loved ones and encouraged anyone not feeling well to stay home. Allendale continued to encourage staff to reach out for support and to utilize our free Employee Assistance Program as an additional benefit and resource.**

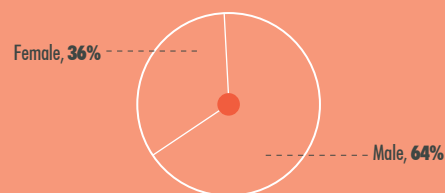

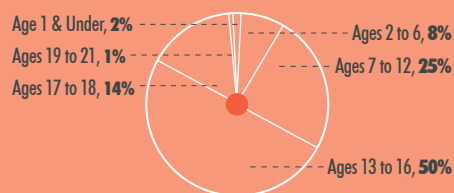

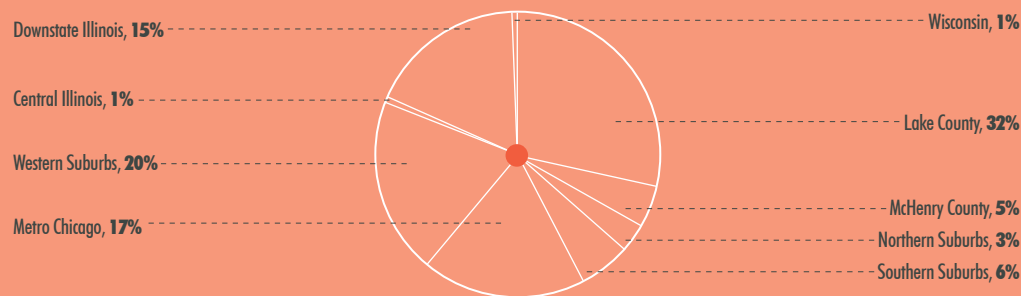
TOTAL YOUTH SERVED BY GENDER:



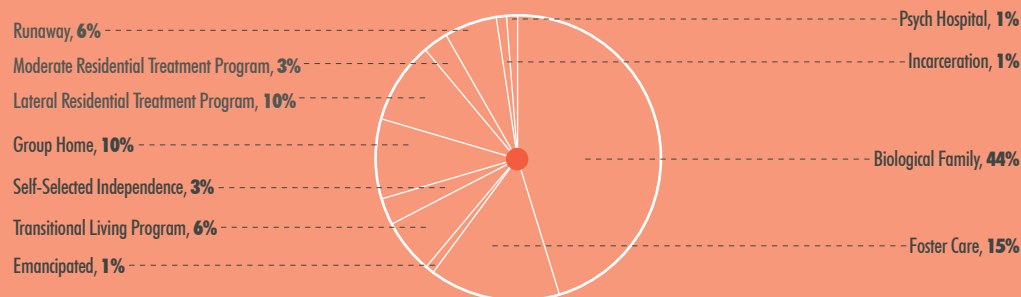
TOTAL YOUTH SERVED BY AGE:
