Through retail business instruction, students learn to create tangible, functional items while also developing a great sense of accomplishment and self-esteem. They acquire independent workplace skills and learn the importance of craftsmanship and customer service.

Through enriching CTE opportunities, students learn to incorporate "real life" situations into their overall education plan helping them to be better prepared for today's workforce.

Project Offerings & Pricelist:

- **Screen Printing:** Shirts - \$25/color for the screen set-up for the first 50 shirts (supplied by customer). Please call for a quote for more than 50 shirts. Customers can also purchase shirts/products through our class/shop!
- **Embroidery:** We can embroider shirts and other assorted items for 0.002 cents per stitch. Many fonts are available for embroidery. There is a one-time set-up fee that applies for custom graphics based on the complexity of the design. Call for ideas and pricing for your design!
- **Vinyl Heat Press:** Great for one-of-a-kind shirts! We can cut-out and heat press your original logos and graphics; or, help create a design for you. Costs vary based on amount of colors and design size and complexity. Call us for a quote!
