Educational Services

<u>Physical Education</u>: Frisbee Golf Discs, 16 Pickle-Ball Paddles, 8 Pickle-Ball balls; maintenance plan for 9 treadmills (\$3,000)

<u>Classroom Furniture</u>: high top chairs/stools, book shelves, rocking movement student chairs, sensory tools
